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Diagnosis and Treatment of Male Sexual Disorders

Thank you for your recent request for information on the treatment of impotence (erectile dysfunction) or other male sexual disorder. These problems may start slowly or happen suddenly, strike at any age, and affect many. I'd like you to know that both help and hope are available.

You have taken the first step by consulting a Urologist who specializes in the treatment of these problems. I have been a Board-certified Urologist for over 30 years. I am a past president of the Rocky Mountain Urological Society and I am on the staffs of several prominent Denver area hospitals. I have also added a male nurse practitioner to the practice. He has been specially trained in the initial evaluation and treatment of patients with sexual dysfunction. This has allowed expansion of the hours when patients may be seen, including Saturday mornings.

Because of a special interest in the management of male sexual disorders, I have developed a program of care offered to all who suffer with such problems. Throughout my medical career I have attended numerous continuing education programs. This area has become the most important part of my medical practice. I have frequently had success with difficult patients in whom other approaches have failed.

There have been exciting new advances in diagnosis as well as treatment and more are on the horizon. Evaluation and therapy are covered by many private insurance plans as well as Medicare. If insurance does not provide benefits, we try to make our program affordable. Extended payments can be arranged. All treatment is individualized according to age, general physical condition, patient motivation, previous experiences and budget. I am personally present for any procedure involving the genitalia.

The impotence treatment pills Viagra®, Levitra®, and Cialis® are available. If not previously tried, free samples of these drugs will be provided after history taking, brief examination, and (possibly) blood testing are completed.

In addition to the management of impotence, good results have been seen with newer treatment methods for the correction of disorders of ejaculation, diminished sexual desire, low testosterone, Peyronies Disease and penile curvature.

The enclosed booklet, *Overcoming Your Impotence*, has recently been revised and edited. This is an overview as well as an introduction to the subject of impotence. I think you will enjoy reading it. Other related information will also be sent to you.
